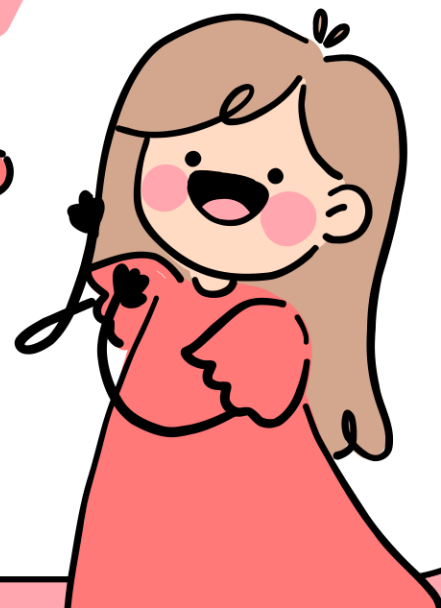

She is **9** years old, **too**.

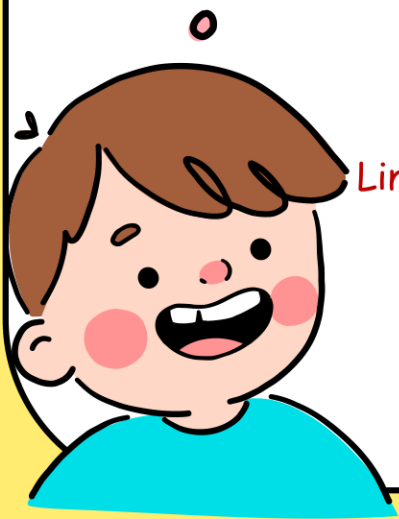
She is really nice and always makes me smile.
